
- We provide a finely tuned 24/7/365 global customer support with a strong focus on direct access to the Registry and a decentralized authority.


- We are a **founding member of the IMO** in 1959 and have since then played a leading and ever-growing role in global shipping.

Core responsibilities in ship registration Recordation & deletion

Irrespective of whether it is a consensual or a forced sale, one of the flag state's core responsibilities is the proper recordation of the vessel, and her deletion, from the ship registry:



Properly record ownership structure



Secure potential mortgages



Properly delete the vessel



Discharge mortgages


The interest of any new owner is always one and the same: The new owner wishes to acquire a liability-free vessel. In the framework of a judicial sale, the owner will be awarded with a clean title to the ship which allows the new owner:

- ✓ the liability risk-free ownership in the vessel,
- ✓ the full operational and entrepreneurial control,
- ✓ the de-registration from her previous flags, and
- the flag change without liabilities for the new flag.



Judicial Sale of Ships The participation of the flag state in Judicial Sales

The judicial sale, or "The forced sale of property authorized or required by a court of law in order to satisfy a debt" has effects on both the outgoing and the incoming registry, for the outgoing in terms of the settlement, or conversely the write-off, of unsettled positions, and for the incoming registry the recordation activities.



Judicial Sale of Ships Flag transfer to Liberia after judicial sale

Consensual sale & purchase

Proof of ownership (regular Bill of Sale)

Certificate of Ownership and Encumbrance from outgoing Flag

Deletion Certificate from outgoing Flag

Vessel may <u>not</u> be sold free and clear of all liens => risk of post sale claims & invoices ⇔ hold harmless letters

Judicial sale

Proof of ownership (court Bill of Sale)

Certificate of Ownership and Encumbrance from outgoing Flag

Deletion Certificate from outgoing Flag

Vessel is sold free and clear of all liens.



Judicial Sale of Ships Deregistration from Liberia after judicial sale




A vessel will only be deregistered if the following requirements are satisfied:

Presentation of an original court Bill of Sale
Prior settlement of open positions




Judicial Sale of Ships Judicial Sale without flag change
