Evis G., Albania:

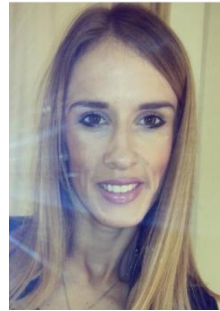


"...Participating for the first time in a well-organized course with different backgrounds personalities in the humanities field offers me new prospective on considering the topics by other optics..." ...
