SUPPORT, SCHOLARSHIPS & CREDIT POINTS

Croatian Ministry of Science and Education has been offering scholarships for Croatian participants for almost two decades. The continuation of this support is expected. IUC offers scholarships to PhD students from the region through the South-East European Scholarship Fund. More info on possible scholarships or a link for a donation on: <https://iuc.hr/scholarships/iuc-support>.

Furthermore, national funding institutions and foundations often provide scholarships or grants for postgraduate courses, e.g. DAAD (German Academic Exchange Service) offering scholarships for IUC courses - <http://daad.de/stipends>. Students from Austria have to look on www.grants.at.

Course and conference participants should approach the academic exchanges service at their home universities for further inquiries.

A certificate of attendance is awarded to each student who attends a full course and satisfactorily completes tasks established by course directors. Course directors secure the recognition of ECTS points at home universities. The decision on number of ECTS points is made in accordance with the university and the respective graduate and research training programme. ECTS points will be measured by the necessary workload of the student to achieve defined learning outcomes and competences. The workload includes time the student needs for lectures, seminars, independent work, reading, learning, writing a paper and presenting a paper and/or exam.

INVITATION TO ORGANIZE AN IUC PROGRAMME

The IUC is open to new entries. The IUC course or conference must be international (organised by at least two professors from two different countries, while lecturers and preferably students should be from at least three different countries) and on the advanced academic level (graduate, postgraduate or post-doc). Organising course and conference directors contact the IUC Secretariat to check the availability of space for a specific date. It is advisable to be flexible with dates, if it is possible.

Courses should have minimum 10, maximum 50 participants. This does not apply for conferences. Course organisers and participants are required to cover participation fees. Organisers coming from paying IUC member universities have a significant discount. It is also advisable to secure the academic points to participants at home universities. Applications for the next academic year with detailed course and conference information are submitted in spring and approved by the IUC Executive Committee. FOUNDATION & HISTORY

The Inter-University Centre has been active for almost five decades. In this period it lived a rich life and took great pride in contributing to international scholarly cooperation. Heading into its 50th anniversary celebration, the Centre is all set to continue its mission.

The idea to establish the Inter-University Centre (IUC) was launched in 1970 at the meeting of the International Association of Universities in Montreal, by Prof. Ivan Supek, at that time Rector of the Univ of Zagreb. He suggested building an institution fully controlled by cooperating scholars & universities, free of government control. The official inauguration took place in 1972, the first meeting of the IUC Council, initiated by 21 founding members.

The IUC is set as a consortium of universities and other scientific institutions. Those are represented on IUC's Council and contribute toward the development of the IUC academic programmes. Dubrovnik was chosen as seat of the IUC because of its rich history as an independent city-state, prospering in the difficult position between East and West, between different religions and cultures.

The City of Dubrovnik offered a building that could serve as a home for the international centre envisioned by Prof. Supek.

The Centre could not have been established without the generosity of the University of Zagreb that has been offering logistical support from the very beginning, while the IUC has given much in return by connecting young scholars from Croatia to active international networks.

From the very beginning, the IUC responded to current needs. During the Cold War, concerned scholars saw the importance of creating new opportunities for contact, knowledge exchange and ideas across division lines. There was a wish to strengthen the role of scientists in bridge building between nations and cultures, ideologies and political systems. The former Yugoslavia, as a non-aligned country, provided conditions for contacts that could not otherwise be achieved. The IUC served as a breathing-hole between East and West. The Inter-University Centre soon became a place for vibrant academic exchange. It grew to more than 250 member institutions before the outbreak of the Homeland war in 1991, when former Yugoslavia fell apart and Croatia sought its independence. Following the war, the number of member universities has declined to approx 170, but the IUC continued with its mission to bring together the academic community from the region. The support of Open Society Foundation greatly helped offering scholarships to PhD candidates from former communist countries of the SE and E European Region.

One of the main features of IUC programmes in all these decades are tackling most recent and up to date academic topics through interdisciplinary or trans-disciplinary approach. Today, the level of programme activities in courses and conferences remains as high as ever and IUC governing bodies are supporting inter-disciplinary and cross-national collaboration on global challenges. The IUC is also developing new features such as blended programmes – boosted by the Corona pandemic restrictions, online publications of IUC Working Papers and open video lectures that derived from its programmes. In the Post-Corona Period, certainly scholars, students and teachers are coming again to develop new connections, learn from each other and about each other.

IUC Council. The IUC is structured as a consortium of universities and other scientific institutions forming the Centre's policies and objectives. Each Member Institution delegates one representative to the Council, which is the policy-making and the highest governing body of the IUC. Also it is responsible for the Constitution of the Centre, admission of new members, establishment of fields of study and academic cooperation, budgetary matters, Executive Committee election & appointment of the Director General. It is chaired by Chair of the Council.

Executive Committee acts on behalf of the Council between Council Meetings on the formation of the annual academic programme, acceptance of budget and financial reports and agreements & contracts with other institutions. It is chaired by Chair of the Executive Committee.

Director General is responsible for the functioning of the Centre, its programmes and finances.

IUC Association provides a legal basis for the functioning of the Centre, for the personnel, premises, equipment and required funding. It was registered in November 1994 in order to provide the continuity of the institution in the new legal settings of the Republic of Croatia. It is chaired by President of the Association.

All governing functions at the IUC are performed by dedicated members on voluntary basis.
