IUC: Where Ideas Meet - and Confront Through Dialogue

For more than five decades, the Inter - University Centre Dubrovnik (IUC) has been more than an academic venue. It has been a meeting place for ideas, a catalyst for dialogue, and a space where academic freedom is not assumed - but actively practiced and defended.

Founded in 1972, the IUC was built on a simple but powerful premise: an institution governed by universities, independent of political influence, and open to the world. This principle continues to guide its mission today.

From the outset, the IUC has brought together a broad international network of universities and scholars who understood that intellectual exchange must transcend borders. Over the years, the Centre has hosted hundreds of courses, conferences, and research initiatives across the humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences. These programmes have fostered a culture of critical thinking, collaboration, and innovation - bringing together participants from diverse countries, cultures, and academic traditions.

Today, that mission is more urgent than ever.

We live in a time of growing polarization, geopolitical tension, and global crises - from conflicts and mass atrocities to inequality and environmental degradation. In such a context, independent academic spaces are not a luxury; they are a necessity. The IUC offers a rare environment where diverse perspectives can confront one another, where difficult and sometimes uncomfortable questions can be addressed, and where meaningful dialogue remains possible.

At the centre of this mission lies academic freedom.

Academic freedom is not only a professional privilege; it is a condition for credible knowledge and a cornerstone of democratic societies. Yet it is increasingly under pressure worldwide. Restrictions, political interference, and more subtle forms of control are reshaping the landscape of higher education and research.

The IUC is responding.

Through a new series of workshops and a major conference in 2027, marking its 55th anniversary, the Centre is strengthening its commitment to defending and advancing academic freedom. The first workshop - Academic Freedom in Context: Trends in Threats and Coping Practices - brings together academics, institutions, NGOs, and international organizations. Future workshops in Zagreb and Dubrovnik will focus on the next generation of scholars and on the broader social and economic dimensions of academic freedom.

These initiatives build on the IUC's long-standing academic programmes and reaffirm its role not only as a place of learning, but as a guardian of human rights and open inquiry.

We invite you to be part of this effort - by joining our courses, contributing to our debates, and engaging with a global community committed to knowledge, dialogue, and freedom.

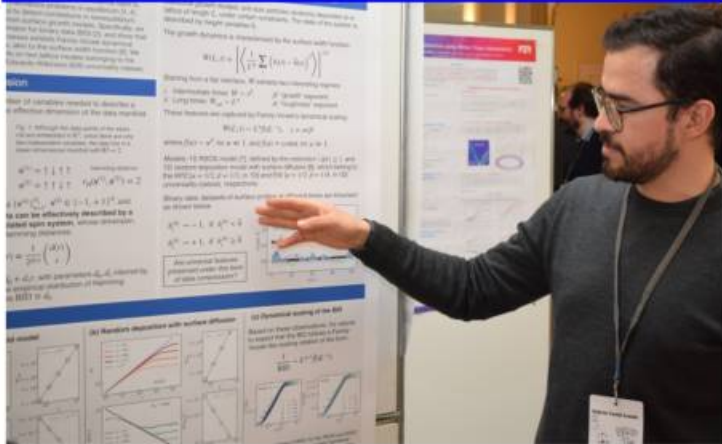
