About the Program

Primary objective of the Summer Stroke School Scholarship Program is to encourage cooperation and to promote exchange of knowledge between participants from different countries. - 4. A one page cover letter outlining your reasons and motivation for applying
- 5. Your CV (A summary of your work experience and other relevant activities)
- 6. A letter(s) of recommendation (optionally)
