TIME - TABLE

The work of the workshop will be organized both in sessions for the presentation of papers and in workshops on related topics. The organizers will make every effort to ensure that there will be no parallel sections in order to encourage the fullest participation.

The conference will begin on the morning of Monday, August 19, 2019, and close on Saturday evening, August 24.

Participants should plan to arrive by the evening of Sunday, August 18, and the departure should be planned not earlier than the following Sunday morning, August 25. The working hours for the conference are planned from 9am to 1 pm and from 5pm to 7pm, with breaks for coffee every day except the excursion day. The total time for presentation of a paper is expected to be 30 minutes: 20 minutes for the paper and 10 minutes for discussion.

PAPERS AND WORKSHOPS

You are invited to register and to announce

After you have sent us the abstracts of your papers or proposals for workshops, the Board will make the selection and determine the list of the accepted participants with papers, and of workshops with the names of their conveners, that have been accepted by the Board.

The registration of auditors does not undergo any selection by the Board.

After the assessment the Organizing Board will prepare the final timetable with the abstracts. It will be sent to all the participants by e-mail in advance and you will receive the printed booklet at the conference.

COMMUNICATION

After you receive the confirmation of your paper or workshop proposal, kindly send us to the same addresses the information whether you have paid your registration fee, have you paid it by a money order, or by a cheque, or you prefer to pay it upon arrival. Let us equally know whether you have booked your accomodation, and what accomodation you have chosen.

When you book your flights, or decide to come by other means, let us also know the time of your arrival, especially if you choose to stay in the IUC, because it is helpful if we inform the staff at the Inter-University Centre about the time of your arrival, in order to spare you waiting in front of the Centre, since it will be Sunday, and the staff possibly will not be all the time in the Centre, but they will be there when you come if they know the approximate time.

The accomodation is possible in the Dormitory of the Inter-University Centre, Dubrovnik, in the same building where the International Vedic Workshop will take place. The organizers have already booked all the single and double rooms (always with bathroom) in the building for the participants of our Workshop, but the capacities that will not be booked by participants until July 1 may after that date be offered to other interested guests of the IUC.

It is also possible to book accomodation in Dubrovnik hotels (here is a selection of relatively less expensive ones), but the booking should be made as early as possible, because Dubrovnik is a very demanded destination, especially in summer.

A third possibility is accomodation in private houses. It is usually well equipped, clean and comfortable, and less expensive than hotel accomodation. If you choose this option, ask for the location somewhere in the neighbourhood of the IUC (Pile, Old City or Ploče).

In any case, to be sure to secure the accomodation, the earlier you make decision and book, the better.

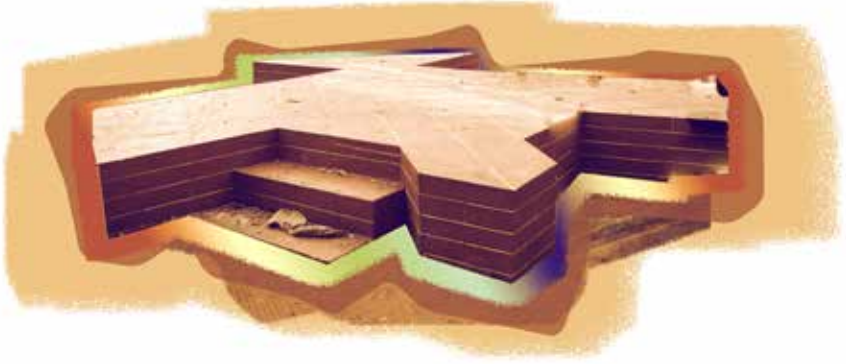
